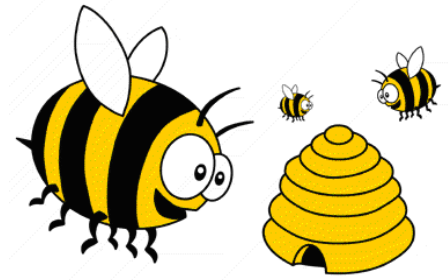

- Materials will be selected to help children to develop their self-respect and to respect other people, avoiding stereotypes and derogatory pictures or messages about any groups of people.

- Busy Bees aims to show respectful awareness of all major events in the lives of our children and families. We will therefore celebrate and acknowledge a variety of festivals.

### **Employment**

- Busy Bees will always appoint the best person for each job, we will treat all applicants fairly and without prejudice.

### **Additional Needs**

- Busy Bees recognises that all children have a wide range of needs, that differ from time to time and from one child to another. We will always consider what part we can play to meet the individual needs of all children and how to provide opportunities which will help each child to reach their full potential.

### **Food**

- We work tirelessly in partnership with our parents and families to ensure that each child's individual medical, cultural and dietary needs are met.
